The AWAY CODE

This Code of conduct applies to all Inner Circle Academy students AND any accompanying supporters, parents, guardians, specifically while travelling, attending seminars, demonstrations, public events or other dojos and whilst representing Inner Circle Academy in any capacity in any dojo and in public.

- 1) Your behaviour is required to be impeccable.
- 2) You are responsible and accountable for your own behaviour and also ensuring your that team members act within this code at all times.
- 3) Under 18s must be supervised by their guardian or a trained approved adult chaperone, a designated Black/Black Stripe Belt at all times. (including while on the mat)
- 4) Unless an approved chaperone, unrelated adults will not share accommodations, lone passenger situations or any other solo interactions with under 18s. (All exceptions and breaches must be reported & recorded).
- 5) While not in training, your behaviour is also required to be impeccable, including appropriate & modest dress.
- 6) While training you are required to follow the protocols of the host dojo or club.
 - I. Acquaint yourself with host dojo/club protocols including Child Safety Standards (different in each state).
 - II. If in doubt or Inner Circle Academy protocols are supercessive, use the Inner Circle Academy protocols.
- 7) Demonstrate proper respects and courtesies towards instructors, officials, other martial artists, other attendees facilities and equipment. This includes members of the public and accommodation staff.
- 8) There is a zero tolerance policy for the abuse of drugs or alcohol. Compromised behaviour will result in you being sent home at your own expense.
- 9) Observe all curfews and other instructions of team leaders and dorm leaders. Please respect the privacy of people you are sharing accommodation with.
- 10) Show respect for the authority of the instructors and the skills of other martial artists, even though you will sometimes disagree with their instructions. Give every technique or opportunity your best effort and find a way to take some learning from it.
- 11) Try to train with members of other clubs when you can. Foster good relationships and cooperative spirit. Do not criticise the technique taught to other students as you will be vicariously criticising their instructor and club. Let your technique do the talking.
- 12) Conduct yourself with honour and dignity and treat others as you would like to be treated, as you would in your own doio.
- 13) While travelling all students are required to make a reasonable contribution to the tasks associated with the away event. Everyone should help out as best they can, without being asked.
